

Guidelines for Poster Paper Presentations

Content

Posters may highlight Young or Dragon 4 scientists latest research results or research plans if at an early stage in their studies

Dimensions of Poster Presentations

- Poster width should not exceed 90 cm (36").
- Poster height should not exceed 122 cm (48").

Design and Format

- Use graphs, charts and illustrations as much as possible. Minimize use of text and tables.
- Use large bold lettering for readability (minimum font size 14pt non-serif e.g. Arial).
- Graphic poster presentations should be readable from 2.5m away.
- The use of colour graphics will enhance poster readability and attractiveness.

Content

- Title: **BOLD AND UPPER CASE**, followed by author's name and affiliation; include email addresses and web addresses if appropriate.
- Abstract: do not to exceed 500 words
- Introduction
- Objective (including study area if have)
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- Major references (maximum of 5 citations)
- Use borders or white space to separate sections.

Mounting

All posters shall be mounted ahead of the poster session, **i.e. starting from Monday 26 afternoon until Tuesday 27 June lunchtime.** Materials for mounting posters will be provided at the poster session venue.

Poster Presentation Session

Young & Dragon scientists will be expected to present their posters to the Dragon 4 cooperation scientific community at a dedicated session on the afternoon of Tuesday 27 June 2017, from 16:00 to 17:30. **NB. this session will not be adjudicated.** Please support your poster during the session and be prepared to answer questions. Also take the opportunity to read other posters and exchange contact information. Poster presenters may want to have A4 copies of their posters and their business cards available for distribution.

The posters will remain on display for all the duration of the symposium. They can be dismounted on Friday 30 June 2017 during the morning coffee break at the latest. All the posters left behind in the Poster Session room shall be dismissed after the event.

Up-load your poster for inclusion in the Symposium on-line programme

Please also provide your poster in electronic format (.pdf version) following the Symposium and no later than Friday 7 July 2017. Up-load the .pdf of your poster to the associated abstract in your Conftool user account: <u>https://www.conftool.pro/2017DragonSymp/</u>. Please note that there is an upper memory size limit of 20MB for up-load files.
