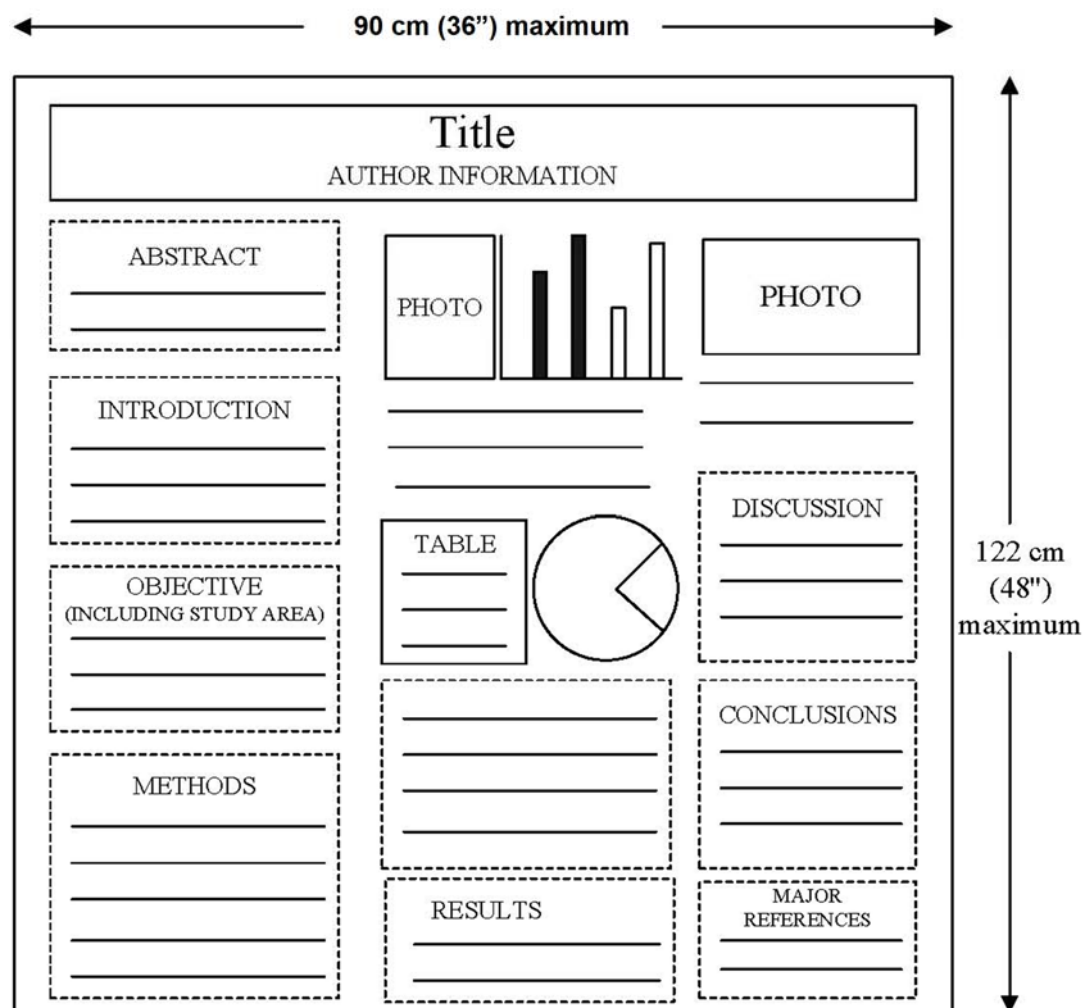
Content

Posters may present research results or research plans by young or Dragon 4 scientists.

Dimensions of Poster Presentations

- Poster width should not exceed 90 cm (36").
- Poster height should not exceed 122 cm (48").

See following diagram.



Design and Format

- Use graphs, charts and illustrations as much as possible. Minimize use of text and tables.
- Use large bold lettering for readability (minimum font size 14pt non-serif e.g. Arial).
- Graphic poster presentations should be readable from 2.5m away.
- The use of colour graphics will enhance poster readability and attractiveness.

Content

- Title: **BOLD AND UPPER CASE**, followed by author's name and affiliation; include email addresses and web addresses if appropriate.
- Abstract: - do not to exceed 500 words
- Introduction
- Objective (including study area if have)
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- Major references (maximum of 5 citations)
- Use borders or white space to separate sections.

Mounting

The posters shall be mounted by presenters themselves, in the poster session area ahead of the session by no later than 12:00 on Tuesday 25 June 2019. Please check that your poster is located on the correct board and in the correct category. The posters shall be removed by young scientists themselves by no later than Thursday 27 June 17:30. The conference center will not be responsible for posters after this deadline.

Poster Presentation Session

Young & Dragon scientists shall present their posters to the Dragon 4 scientific community at a dedicated session on the afternoon of Tuesday 25 June 2019, from 16:00 to 17:30. Senior & lead scientists will be present to read the posters and ask questions. There will be certificates and prizes awarded for the best posters in each category. Poster presenters may want to have A4 copies of their posters and their business cards available for distribution.

Electronic format for inclusion in the on-line Symposium programme

Please also provide your poster in electronic format (.pdf version), by up-load to the associated abstract in your Conftool user account **by no later 21 June 2019** (i.e. the Friday before the start of the Symposium) <https://www.conftool.pro/2019DragonSymp/> .

Please follow the convention for file naming:

Poster abstract number-author surname.pdf **e.g. 12345-smith.pdf**

Please note the upper file size limit is 20MB for upload in the Conftool.
